To help celebrate the unofficial end of Summer, the *Park Ridge Recreation Committee and Cultural Committee* presents an evening full of music and fun on Saturday, September 4th starting at 6:00 at the Park Ridge High School Track and Football field. The fireworks show will start at dusk (approximately 8:00 PM). The rain date, if necessary, is Sunday the 5th.

Due to budget cut backs, the 2010 fireworks show is only possible through the generous donations of many local businesses and persistent hard work was the *Park Ridge Rec Committee* able to organize this year's fireworks spectacular. This year's fireworks will be expertly performed by *July 4 Ever* of Walden, NY – the same company that Park Ridge has used in past few years and by other local towns in the Pascack Valley.

The *Park Ridge Recreation and Cultural Committee* has organized the celebration including the evening's entertainment from the "17th Street Band." Arrive Early

As parking is limited, Park Ridge residents are strongly encouraged to *arrive early* and enjoy the music, bounce house, food, and beverages prior to the fireworks.

As in year's past, residents are welcome to bring folding chairs and blankets to make their listening and viewing more comfortable. Suggested parking lots include Sulak (by the Recycling Center), behind borough hall, and the commuter lot on the corner of Hawthorne and Madison Avenues.

New this year is a shuttle bus service from the commuter lot on Hawthorne Ave to the tennis courts and back provided courtesy of *The Plaza of Mill Pond*.
