SECTION 2. In addition to the salaries set forth above, department heads and other eligible employees shall be paid longevity pay on the following basis: (a) 49^{th} month through 60^{dh} month of service: \$500 for that year of service; (b) 61^{st} through 120^{th} month of service: \$300 per year for each year of service; (c) 121^{st} month and over: \$200 per year for each year of service. Payments shall be part of the semi-monthly pay.

SECTION 3. All salaries shall be retroactive to January 1, 2020.

SECTION 4. In addition to the salaries set forth herein employees in the following positions shall be paid an additional sum of \$1,500, said amount to be designated, "Exempt Stipend," in recognition of the additional hours and duties required of their positions. The eligible positions are: Deputy Borough Clerk, Ass't Treasurer, General Supervisors of Electric Distribution, Roads/Parks/Bldgs & Grounds/Vchicle Maint., Water Distribution and Sewer Maintenance, Project Engineer and Zoning Officer.

SECTION 5. In addition to the salary set forth herein, the Borough Administrator, Borough Clerk, Treasurer and Director of Operations positions shall be paid an additional sum of \$2,500, said amount to be designated as "Administrative Excinpt Stipend" in recognition of the additional hours and duties required of their positions.

SECTION 6. In addition to the salary set forth herein, the Fire Official, P.T., shall each be paid an additional stipend of \$750 in recognition of additional hours required as the administrative duties associated with residential smoke detector certifications.

SECTION 7. In addition to the salaries set forth herein, the Fire Official, P.T., and the Zoning Officer, P.T., shall be paid an additional stipend of \$750 each in recognition of additional hours associated with the Mayor's Housing Task Force.

SECTION 8. In addition to salary set forth herein, the Fire Officials, P.T., shall each be paid an additional \$17.00 per hour for court appearances in recognition of the hours spent in Court associated with summons issued for violations.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A:4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% or the cost of living adjustment, whichever is less, unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of living adjustment for calendar year 2020 budget is calculated at 2.5% pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2 and amounts to \$269,767; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Park Ridge in the County of Bergen finds it's advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2020 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that an additional 1.0% increase in the budget of said year, amounting to \$107,907 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.



WHEREAS, the Borough of Park Ridge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") from time to time issues bonds, notes and other obligations, the interest on which is excluded from gross income for Federal income tax purposes, and desires to take such action as may be necessary or advisable to establish and maintain such exclusion; and

WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), contains provisions with respect to the exclusion from gross income for Federal income tax purposes of interest on obligations, including provisions, among others, which require issuers of tax-exempt obligations, such as the Borough to account for and rebate certain arbitrage earnings to the United States Treasury and to take other action to establish and maintain such Federal tax exclusion; and

WHEREAS, the Borough intends to issue a \$2,564,400 bond anticipation note, dated May 1, 2020, payable April 30, 2021 (the "Note"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to designate the Note as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Park Ridge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Borough Council hereby covenants on behalf of the Borough, to the extent permitted by the Constitution and the laws of the State of New Jersey, to do and perform all acts and things permitted by law and necessary to assure that interest paid on bonds, notes and other obligations of the Borough (including the Note) be and remain excluded from gross income of the owners thereof for Federal income tax purposes pursuant to Section 103 of the Code.

SECTION 2. The Mayor, Borough Clerk, Chief Financial Officer and the other officials of the Borough are hereby authorized and directed to take such action, make such representations and give such assurances as they may deem necessary or advisable to effect compliance with the Code.

SECTION 3. The Note is hereby designated as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" for the purpose of Section 265(b)(3) of the Code.

SECTION 4. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said Note is not a "private activity bond" as defined in the Code and (2) the Borough and its subordinate entities, if any, do not reasonably anticipate issuing in excess of \$10 million of new money tax-exempt obligations (other than private activity bonds) during the calendar year 2020.

SECTION 5. It is further determined and stated that the Borough has not, as of the date hereof, issued any tax exempt obligations (other than the Note) during the calendar year 2020.

SECTION 6. The Borough will, to the best of its ability, attempt to comply with respect to the limitations on issuance of tax-exempt obligations pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Code; however, said Borough does not covenant to do so, and hereby expressly states that a covenant is not made hereby.

SECTION 7. The issuing officers of the Borough are hereby authorized to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the original purchaser of the Note and to further provide such original purchaser with a certificate of obligations issued during the calendar year 2020 dated as of the date of delivery of the Note.

BERGEN MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE BENEFITS FUND INDEMNITY AND TRUST AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 28day of April 2020, in the County of

Bergen State of New Jersey, By and Between the Bergen Municipal Employee Benefits Fund referred to as "FUND" and the governing body of the Borough of Park Ridge a duly constituted LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT, hereinafter referred to as "LOCAL UNIT".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of various local units of government, as defined in N.J.A.C. 11:15-3.2, have collectively formed a Joint Insurance Fund as such an entity is authorized and described in <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:10-36 et. seq. and the administrative regulations promulgated pursuant thereto; and

WHEREAS, the LOCAL UNIT has agreed to become a member of the FUND in accordance with and to the extent provided for in the Bylaws of the FUND and in consideration of such obligations and benefits to be shared by the membership of the FUND;

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

1. The LOCAL UNIT accepts the FUND's Bylaws as approved and adopted and agrees to be bound by and to comply with each and every provision of said Bylaws and the pertinent statutes and administrative regulations pertaining to same.

2. The LOCAL UNIT agrees to participate in the FUND with respect to health insurance, as defined in <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 17B:17-4, and as authorized in the LOCAL UNIT's resolution to join.

3. The LOCAL UNIT agrees to become a member of the FUND and to participate in the health insurance coverages offered for an initial period, (subject to early release or termination pursuant to the Bylaws), such membership to commence on **January 1**, 2020 and ending on **December 31**, 2022 at 12:01 AM provided, however, that the LOCAL UNIT may withdraw at any time upon 90 day written notice to the FUND.

4. The LOCAL UNIT certifies that it has never defaulted on payment of any claims if self-insured and has not been cancelled for non-payment of insurance premiums for a period of at least two (2) years prior to the date of this Agreement.

5. In consideration of membership in the FUND, the LOCAL UNIT agrees that it shall jointly and severally assume and discharge the liability of each and every member of the FUND, for the periods during which the member is receiving coverage, all of whom as a condition of membership in the FUND shall execute an Indemnity and Trust Agreement similar to this Agreement and by execution hereto, the full faith and credit of the LOCAL UNIT is pledged to the punctual payments of any sums which shall become due to the FUND in accordance with the Bylaws thereof, this Agreement or any applicable Statute. However, nothing herein shall be construed as an obligation of the LOCAL UNIT for claims and expenses that are not covered by the FUND, or for that portion of any claim or liability within the LOCAL UNIT retained limit or in an amount which exceeds the FUND's limit of coverage.

6. If the FUND in the enforcement of any part of this Agreement shall incur necessary expenses or become obligated to pay attorncy's fees and/or court costs, the LOCAL UNIT agrees to reimburse the FUND for all such reasonable expenses, fees, and costs on demand.

7. The LOCAL UNIT and the FUND agree that the FUND shall hold all moneys in excess of the LOCAL UNIT's retained loss fund paid by the LOCAL UNIT to the FUND as fiduciaries for the benefit of FUND claimants all in accordance with N.J.A.C. 11:15-3 et. seq.

8. The FUND shall establish and maintain Claims Trust Accounts for the payment of health insurance claims in accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:10-36 et. seq., <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:5-1 and such other statutes and regulations as may be applicable. More specifically, the aforementioned Trust Accounts shall be utilized solely for the payment of claims, allocated claim expense and stop loss insurance or reinsurance premiums for each risk or liability as follows:

- a) Employer contributions to group health insurance
- b) Employee contributions to contributory group health insurance
- c) Employer contributions to contingency account
- d) Employee contributions to contingency account
- c) Other trust accounts as required by the Commissioner of Insurance

9. Notwithstanding 8 above, to the contrary, the FUND shall not be required to establish separate trust accounts for employee contributions provided the FUND provides a plan in its Bylaws for the recording and accounting of employee contributions of each member.

 Each LOCAL UNIT of government who shall become a member of the FUND shall be obligated to execute an Indemnity and Trust Agreement similar to this Agreement.

BERGEN MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE BENEFITS FUND

WHEREAS, a number of public entities in the State of New Jersey have joined together to form the Bergen Municipal Employee Benefits Fund, hereafter referred to as "FUND", as permitted by N.J.S.A. 11:15-3, 17:1-8.1, and 40A:10-36 et seq., and;

WHEREAS, the FUND was approved to become operational by the Departments of Insurance and Community Affairs and has been operational since that date, and;

WHEREAS, the statutes and regulations governing the creation and operation of a joint insurance fund, contain certain elaborate restrictions and safeguards concerning the safe and efficient administration of the public interest entrusted to such a FUND;

WHEREAS, the governing body of Borough of Park Ridge hereinafter referred to as "LOCAL UNIT" has determined that membership in the FUND is in the best interest of the LOCAL UNIT.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governing body of the LOCAL UNIT is authorized and directed to execute the Indemnity and 'Trust Agreement and such other documents signifying membership in the FUND as required by the FUND's Bylaws, and to deliver these documents to the FUND's Executive Director with the express reservation that these documents shall become effective only upon:

- i. Approval of the LOCAL UNIT by the FUND.
- Receipt from the LOCAL UNIT of a Resolution accepting assessment.
- Approval by the New Jersey Department of Insurance and Department of Community Affairs.
