REPORTS OF THE GOVERNING BODY

Councilmember Hoffman: I want to thank our local American Legion Post for a beautiful ceremony that they had on Veterans Day. That day means a lot to a lot of people and these people gave their lives to our country and it was just a beautiful ceremony. They had a little reception at the end too which was also very nice. I thank them again for that. Coming up the recreation committee this Sunday the 3rd is going to have our annual holiday tree lighting at Depot Square starts I believe at 5:00 p.m. We're going to have the marching band, the cheerleaders, and it will be a big town gathering so I encourage everyone to come and see the tree lit up.

Councilmember Ferguson: I hope everyone had a great Thanksgiving weekend, I know for me personally it's my favorite holiday of the year there's no commercialization of it, so it's family food football and fun. PKRG-TV, Park Ridge, is pleased to announce its 15th Annual Holiday Lights Contest and TV program. Park Ridge residents can enter online by 9pm on December 15th by visiting <u>www.pkrgtv.com</u> Contest winners will be announced in a program, featuring holiday music videos of contestant displays, airing on PKRG-TV on 12/24 at 8pm. The PBA Toy Drive that is now taking place up until December 14th The Park Ridge Police is asking that if anyone is able to donate a new unwrapped toy for a child of any age, it would be greatly appreciated to help those in need. They have a collection bin at their HQ Lobby, and also bins located by the lobbies of PRHS, West Ridge, and East Brook.

Councilmember Cozzi: We had our meetings for the Utility and the Library. I would like to point out that the utility is working very hard and now working civilly with Landmark working on getting the electric load over there along with PSE&G. it is a big job and there is a lot going on. I would also like to bring up that the substation that is built by Mill Pond is going along swimmingly and will be online soon. Regarding the library committee, I just want to bring up that we've got another town added to the buckles program, so that's that many more books that can be accessed. Then you know now they have access to whatever video library or Digital Library they have so it's growing. We have a great system with bags and your names on it to pick up books and if you look downstairs a lot of people use it and it is great for our residents. Families love it. Council President Fenwick: As Mr. Metzdorf have noted there were some resolutions on the agenda tonight to facilitate the acquisition of a parcel of property up on North Fifth Street. This has been something that we've been working on for quite some time, I know it had been discussed at points prior to me even being on the council . This year I was happy to discuss at length with the owner of that property to facilitate its acquisition for open space. I want to thank the rest of the council for voting to move forward with that project. We're going to be applying for Green Acres money and I know that there's going to be a message that goes out to all of our residents. Green Acres wants to hear from our residents, they want to hear whether or

not the people of Park Ridge actually want to preserve this land. I imagine they do. Additionally we had a meeting of the shared services committee as some may have heard Judge Norton is retiring and our prosecutor who's done a great job this year Mr Wellinghorst is also stepping down, we are looking for a new Prosecutor and the applications are up and can be accessed on the Borough of Montvale website. They are due next week. The shared services committee is also recommending Chris Bota and Anthony Bocchi to be hired as the new municipal judge for the joint court. That process is in the hands of the Governor at this point and the Senate. They will get to pick our new judge, based on the way the shared court is set up with state law it is out of our hands now. I would also like to echo everyone's comments regarding the Veterans Day ceremony. I was there too it was a beautiful ceremony. I want to thank Commander Oppelt and the rest of the Legion for inviting our community.

Mayor Misciagna: I'll echo what all you gentlemen have said about the Legion, Veterans Day was a really nice ceremony I was honored to speak. I tried to remind people that Veterans Day is unlike Memorial Day, where it's a celebration of who we have defending us and not a somber ceremony as Memorial Day is. They did a wonderful job as always and I appreciate it being part of that. I also did want to compliment everybody here for the purchase of the North Fifth parcel. I want to remind everybody this was a two-parcel purchase. A couple years ago Rob Metzdorf was instrumental in the first part of that, and we were able to get Open Space money for that purchase. I am very much in favor of acquiring this property and protecting our open space and acquiring as much as we can. I was going to comment on the tri-boro court, but it's in the Governor's hands right now and we will know soon enough.
