REPORTS OF THE GOVERNING BODY

Councilmember Hoffman: I want to thank our local American Legion Post for a beautiful ceremony that they had on Veterans Day. I thank them again for that. Coming up the recreation committee this Sunday the 3rd is going to have our annual holiday tree lighting at Depot Square starts I believe at 5:00 p.m. We're going to have the marching band, the cheerleaders, and it will be a big town gathering so I encourage everyone to come and see the tree lit up.

Councilmember Ferguson: I hope everyone had a great Thanksgiving weekend, I know for me personally it's my favorite holiday of the year there's no commercialization of it, so it's family food football and fun. PKRG-TV, Park Ridge, is pleased to announce its 15th Annual Holiday Lights Contest and TV program. 
