Councilmember Goldsmith: The Board of Health did not really meet this month, but there were two names submitted for the vacancies and they are going through a final review. One is Sean Trumble from Park Ridge and is involved in the Ironhorse restaurant in Westwood, so I did support his nomination. The pool commission got together for Holiday dinner, and we did discuss how the pool ran this past year. I concur with Greg and thank the town and all the council members, I think we worked great together this year and did a lot of positive things. I really hope we continue that with the new council in the new year.

Council President Fenwick: I want to echo Mr. Hall's state menta bour North 5<sup>th</sup> St. property, the town may not know, but you know we've been negotiating all year regarding this property. I've probably gotten more phone calls about this than many other issues and I'm very thankful that the council agreed to move forward with this project. I know it's been pending for some time and this is the second open space acquisition we've done this year. We also acquired another piece of property off of Forest Street that the town had looked at purchasing decades ago so I'm happy to see that Park Ridge will remain a community filled with open space. I did attend the Christmas tree lighting and it was a wonderful thing to see there were tons of our residents there, more than I've seen in years. I would like to wish everyone a Happy Holidays, Merry Christmas, Happy Hanukkah and Happy New Year. I myself am very proud of all the hard work that this Council accomplished this year. I'm thankful for the opportunity I've had to serve in the Borough and the people of Park Ridge. I will reserve my lengthy remarks so the Sine Die meeting.

Mayor Misciagna: I would like to thank Liz Falkenstern our Recreation Director and the Recreation Committee for doing another great job with the tree lighting, I know if had to be rescheduled because of the weather. We had a lot of people and kids and the best hot chocolate,

it was wonderful to spend the time with everyone as a community. I would like to thank them for having the tradition going, it's a lot of fun. One of our newer traditions is that we had the menorah lighting. A very heartwarming program, the Rabbi came and talked about the symbolism of a menorah. It's the symbolism of light in a dark world and I think that rings very true this year with everything that is going on in the world. I enjoyed that very much. Or downtown is starting to fill up the stores at the James. I had the pleasure of attending the grand opening of the Spine & Health Center in Park Ridge and SkinSpirit, both located on 146 Kinderkamack Road in the James Building and we have Beer Works coming in there. In light of the election results, I will be replacing Council President Fenwick with Councilman Ferguson on the Shared Services committee so it will be John Ferguson and Matt Capilli on shared services and court liaison.
