BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 2019-030

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 98 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE, NEW JERSEY ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WATER RATES WITHIN THE BOROUGH PARK RIDGE AND SO MUCH OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODCLIFF LAKE SERVICED BY THE PARK RIDGE WATER DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have received the recommendation of the Park Ridge Board of Public Works to implement a rate increase for the service of water within the Borough Park Ridge and so much of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake serviced by the Park Ridge Water Department; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have carefully considered these recommendations and reviewed all of the appropriate supporting documentation; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council agree with the Park Ridge Board of Public Works that this rate increase is in the best interest of the users of the water supply system; and

WHEREAS, the last water rate increase was implemented on January 1, 2018,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough Park Ridge as follows:

SECTION ONE: Chapter 98-2 of the Code of the Borough of Park Ridge is hereby amended to read as follows:

98-2 WATER RATES.

- 1. The following rates are hereby fixed for the sale of water by the Park Ridge Water Department within the Borough of Park Ridge and so much of the Borough of Woodcliff Lake as is serviced by the Borough of Park Ridge Water Department effective for all water bills rendered as of January 1, 2020:
- Moter Service Rates. Whenever the term "fixed charge" is used in this Ordinance, said fixed charge shall be in addition to any applicable charges for water consumption:
- A) General Meter Service. This rate shall be applicable to use of water supplied through meters.
 - a. Fixed Charge does not include any water consumption.

b. Meter Rates - for each gallon consumed during quarter \$4.64 per 1,000 gallons. This rate includes the State Water Tax pursuant to L. 1983, c. 443.

- B) General Metered Service Senior Citizens. This rate shall be applied to use of water supplied through residential meters when the following criteria and conditions are met:
 - (1) Customer must be at least 65 years of age or totally disabled.
- (2) Customer's household income which is that total income earned by all residents of that household is not to exceed twenty five thousand (\$25,000) Dollars from all sources taxable and non-taxable, but not including Social Security.
- (3) Customer must qualify for Senior Citizen State Tax Exemption of real property or for the state regulated Lifeline Program.
 - (4) All senior citizens to be recertified annually.
 - (5) The Chief Financial Officer shall be the enforcing agent.

Senior Citizen Rates shall be as follows:

- 1. Rate: \$2.32 per 1,000 gallons
- 2. Fixed Charge per quarter: \$8.43
- C. Unmetered Service for Fire Protection. This rate shall be applicable to use of unmetered private fire service and shall be charged for each premise so serviced.
 - 1. Rate: Per Year

- E. Replacement of Damaged Meters: Actual Cost including parts and labor.
- F. Trouble Call-out (when problem is unrelated to service provided by the Park Ridge Water Department): Actual Cost including parts and labor.

SECTION TWO: **Severability.** The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. Should any section, paragraph, subparagraph, provision, sentence, or part hereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional, said finding shall not affect any other section, paragraph, subparagraph, provision, sentence, or part thereof and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

<u>SECTION THREE</u>; Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately following final passage, adoption and publication as provided by law.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), as follows:

Section 1. The total amount of \$20,000 is hereby appropriated by the Borough of Park Ridge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") from the Borough's Capital Fund Surplus for improvements to the Borough Hall including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

Section 2. The capital budget or temporary capital budget, as applicable, of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget, as applicable, and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TO THE CURRENT SALARY ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE SO AS TO ENUMERATE THE COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY FOR THE YEARS 2017-2020.

WHEREAS, from time to time the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Park Ridge revise and update the Borough Salary Ordinance which enumerates the compensation paid to certain employees of the Borough of Park Ridge and is referenced in §2-39 (B).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Park Ridge in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that of the Code of the Borough of Park Ridge Salary Ordinance shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. The Salary Ordinance is amended to add the following:

As provided in the collective bargaining agreement between the Borough of Park Ridge and the Park Ridge Police Benevolent Association – New Jersey State Policemen's Benevolent Association Local #206, the salary to be paid employees covered under this agreement for the years 2018-2020 is:

- B. Those employees in the PO8, PO7, and PO6 designation in 2017 shall remain in those steps for 2018 and thereafter beginning in 2019 move up a step on their anniversary date.
- C. The Probationary Step will apply to the Officer for twelve (12) months from the date of appointment, or until the date of his/her permanent appointment, whichever is later, whereupon step movement shall be to PO-8.

- D. Full time Detectives assigned to the Investigative Services Bureau shall receive an annual Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$2,500.00) stipend payable immediately following the adoption of the annual budget. Part time Detectives assigned to the Investigative Services Bureau shall receive an annual Five Hundred Dollar (\$500.00) stipend payable immediately following the adoption of the annual budget.
- E. Stipends for the Office of Emergency Management shall be:
 - 1. OEM Coordinator shall receive an annual stipend of \$2463
 - 2. Deputy OEM Coordinator shall receive an annual stipend of \$750

SECTION 2. Except as stated in Section 1 above, all other manner of compensation, fringe benefits, vacation, holidays and administration of departmental affairs shall be continued in written agreements between the Borough of Park Ridge and the Park Ridge Police Benevolent Association – New Jersey State Policemen's Benevolent Association Local #206 (which agreement will expire on December 31, 2020). All manner of remuneration shall be effective as indicated hereinbefore.

SECTION 3. As provided in the contract between the Borough of Park Ridge and the Chief of Police, the all-inclusive salary to be paid is \$189,181.60 for calendar year 2018, \$195,743.33 for calendar year 2019 and \$199,658.20 for calendar year 2020. All other manner of compensation, fringe benefits, vacation, holidays and administration of departmental affairs shall be continued in the written agreement between the Borough of Park Ridge and the Park Ridge Police Chief, dated May 31, 2019.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are expressly repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective after final passage and publication as required by law.
