- 2. The assessment for the tax year 2018 shall be reduced from \$24,000,000.00 to \$21,500,000.00.
- 3. The assessment for the tax year 2019 shall be reduced from \$24,000,000.00 to \$18,750,000.00.

4.	Interest on refunds due shall be waived by the taxpayer if refunds are issued within 60 days of
	entry of Judgment.
