I just cannot thank the Utilities and DPW enough, along with the Police and Fire just keeping us safe and keeping the lights on. It's just a wonderful thing to be in the town with that! Speaking of safety: At the Pool - The Pool Staff and the Pool Commission want to thank the citizens who joined the pool and complying with all the safety rules. There has been a lot of other pools, throughout the state, that had to call in the Police because people aren't wearing masks. Everybody has been complying, everybody is having a wonderful time in this heat and using the pool. So, thank you everyone for that! The **Library** is open. It is limited - you can browse books and some other things - the computers aren't being used. It is on the website as to the hours and the limitations. I think there is five people entry at a time. This Sunday, the Pascack Historical Society is going to reopen from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. So, if you want to see a little bit of history, the Historical Society will be open on the street. Two more items. One, is the Census. Please fill out the Census - it is important to us to get our funding and to make sure that we get the appropriate amount from everything. Everything from FEMA, to grants, and everything else. So, please fill out the Census if you haven't done it already! Finally, please be safe - wear those masks in public and please maintain social distancing!
