BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 2022-015

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "REQUIREMENTS OF BUSINESS OWNERS AND MULTIFAMILY UNIT OWNERS TO REGISTER ANNUALLY AND MAINTAIN CERTAIN LEVELS OF LIABILITY INSURANCE" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Park Ridge, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

WHEREAS, Governor Murphy signed into law S-1368 requiring all business owners and owners of multifamily rental units to maintain certain levels of liability insurance; and

WHEREAS, S-1368 also requires all business owners and owners of multifamily rental units to annually register a certificate of insurance with the municipality where the business or rental unit is located; and

WHEREAS, S-1368 authorized municipalities to charge a reasonable administrative fee for the certificate of insurance and a penalty for failing to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

LIABILITY INSURANCE AND ANNUAL REGISTRATION.

A.The owner of a business or the owner of a rental unit or units shall maintain liability insurance for negligent acts and/or omissions in an amount of no less than \$500,000 for combined property damage and bodily injury to or death of one or more persons in any one accident or occurrence.

- B. The owner of a multifamily home which is four or fewer units, one of which is owner occupied, shall maintain liability insurance for negligent acts and/or omissions in an amount of no less than \$300,000 for combined property damage and bodily injury to or death of one or more persons in any one accident or occurrence.
- C. The owner of a business, owner of a rental unit or units and the owner of a multifamily home of four or fewer units, one of which is owner occupied, shall annually register a certificate of insurance with the municipality, earlier than February 1st of each year or within thirty (30) days of obtaining ownership of the property.
- D. There shall be an annual administrative fee in the amount of \$25.00.
- E. Failure to annually register a certificate of insurance on or before February 1st of each year shall result in a fine of \$500.00 which shall be collected through a summary proceeding pursuant to the "Penalty Enforcement Law of 1999", P.L. 1999, c. 274 (C.2A-58-10, et seq.)

<u>Severability</u> All provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected.

<u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final approval and publication, pursuant to law, and upon completion of all outstanding cases.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, DESIGNATING A \$4,650,000 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE, DATED SEPTEMBER 2 8, 2022 AND PAYABLE APRIL 28, 2023, AS A "QUALIFIED TAX-EXEMPT OBLIGATION" PURSUANT TO SECTION 2 65 (b) (3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Park Ridge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough"), intends to issue a \$4,650,000 Bond Anticipation Note, dated September 28, 2022 and payable April 28, 2023 (the "Note"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to designate the Note as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" pursuant to Section 265 (b) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Park Ridge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Note is hereby designated as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" for the purpose of Section 265 (b) (3) of the Code.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the Note is not a "private activity bond" as defined in the Code and (2)the Borough and its subordinate entities, if any, do not reasonably anticipate issuing in excess of \$10 million of new money tax-exempt obligations (other than private activity bonds) during the calendar year 2022.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. It is further determined and stated that the Borough has, as of the date hereof, issued the following tax-exempt obligations (other than the Note) during the calendar year 2022, viz:

Amount \$6,716,000 BAN <u>Dated -Due</u> 4/29/22 -4/28/23

SECTION 4. The Borough will, to the best of its ability, attempt to comply with respect to the limitations on issuance of tax-exempt obligations pursuant to Section 265 (b) (3) of the Code; however, the Borough does not covenant to do so, and hereby expressly states that a covenant is not made hereby.

SECTION 5. The issuing officers of the Borough are hereby authorized to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the original purchaser of the Note and to further provide such original purchaser with a certificate of obligations issued during the calendar year 2022 dated as of the date of delivery of the Note.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
